Late on 23 November 2007, after a festive meal in the dining room of the M/S *Explorer*, most of the ship's 91 passengers had retired to their cabins. A few lingered in the bar, lulled by the now familiar sound of the steel hull crunching through pack ice. The 38-year-old vessel was 12 days into a 19-day GAP Adventures tour that departed from the tip of Argentina and traced the voyages of early 20th-century explorer Ernest Shackleton to the Antarctic Peninsula. It was early in the tourist season, and a particularly cold austral winter had resulted in even more sea ice than usual. But conditions were mild, and the *Explorer*'s captain and crew were veteran Antarctic sailors.
